Copper engraving, 57.5 x 49.5 cms, original hand colour with later additions, minor restoration to upper margin, blank verso. An early impression of one of the most decorative eighteenth-century maps of the British Isles. The portrait probably represents the reigning monarch George I, flanked by Hercules and an allegorical figure representing justice, one of the four cardinal virtues; balancing the main cartouche, which features the Hanoverian coat of arms, are the arms of the three kingdoms and, bottom left, a scale surmounted by the old Stuart arms, next to a bold depiction of the rescue of Andromeda by Perseus.

A satirical map of England and Wales illustrating the 1886 Irish Home Rule crisis for a Conservative periodical. The Tory leader (Lord Salisbury as St George), spears the dragon Gladstone (in 1886 the Liberal Prime Minister), shown with the forked tongue of Home Rule lolling from his mouth; other figures such as Parnell have been worked into his scaly flanks. Although the earliest printed depiction by Tennant of England and Wales as George and the Dragon dates from 1912, it was well known to Meham and his audience 25 years earlier.

January 1933.

Folding pocket map, 15.5 x 22 cms, lithographed in colours and printed on both sides.

The first edition of Harry Beck's iconic diagram, issued with the famously cautious note on the cover: "A new design for an old map. We should welcome your comments". The diagram underwent a number of alterations within the first year of its existence, some stylistic (changing the diamond interchange symbols; experimenting with a compass rose; changing the colour coding of lines) and some reflecting developments on the network (the Cockfosters extension and the escalator extension at Bank). However, the key elements of the design remain with us today, and Beck's diagram is arguably the most original and influential development in twentieth century cartography. Ephemeral items like this were often discarded after use, and examples in good condition have become scarce.

First and only edition. A very sweet publication issued by Hemingway's favourite bar in Havana, La Florida (or La Floridita, as it become better known). The bar is still open in Havana, and has Hemingway's favourite seat at the end of the bar clearly marked, where he apparently liked to sit and drink daquiris. The book contains all the bar's recipes for daquiris (five different kinds) and is written in both Spanish and English. The insides of the covers show advertisements for Bacardi and Hatuey, a popular beer in Cuba in the 30s. Very scarce. No copies located by OCLC.

Many hitherto unseen photographs and diagrams support the detailed text, which benefits from extensive research in the BAC archives and access to newly rediscovered material.



Britains Railways in Colour

This book, covering the early years of diesel on Britain's railways, presents a wonderful array of over 200 colour photographs, many of them previously unpublished. All the imagery is reproduced from original transparencies that have remained carefully preserved away from daylight since the day they were taken, so the original vividness of colour remains - a rare quality. As high-quality colour photography from this period is scarce (most photographers worked mainly in black and white to serve the needs of publishers), this book will delight today's railway enthusiasts, who are always keen to see new material
